OBJECTS OF THE TRUST

1. To open, run, continue educational and vocational institution in healthy and salubrious surroundings in order to propaga~~te~~ the patriotic spirit and ideals of secularism and also to establish a library / community hall, hospital, destitutes house in the name of said national Trust.
