

Subject:-Letter of Affiliation

Consequent upon adoption of recommendations vide resolution number 117 by the state Affiliation Committee in its meeting held on 15th of September, 2012 and as approved by the Chairman, Affiliation is granted to BHARGAVA PUBLIC SCHOOL SUPWAL, VIJAYPUR, SAMBA, to operate /run the academic activities for Classes upto 12th standard in Arts, Science & Commerce stream till March 2014(Class 11th from 2012-13 and subsequently Class 12th from 2013-14) subject to fulfillment of the following conditions within a period of three months from the date of issue of this letter.

Further, the affiliation granted shall strictly be governed by the following resolutions (as were) passed in the Affiliation Committee meeting held on 15th of September, 2012.

- a. A high level committee (comprising member form BOSE & Government) shall revisit the implementation of SRO 123 by the affiliated institutions. The committee shall also took into the scale adopted by the affiliated institutions for formation of fee structure in their respective institutions, besides the frequent and unjustified hikes and charging of fee, under different sub-heads without creating corresponding facilities.
- b. The academic institutions shall furnish an undertaking in respect of toto implementation of SRO 123, this shall be a prerequisite.
- c. The institution should keep themselves readily available for surprise inspections to be conducted by the J&K BOSE. The random inspection shall be caused to different schools to check the credibility of the inspection reports as and when required.
- d. The institutions shall keep all its infrastructure like the Examination Hall, Laboratory and other material, furniture at the disposal of the JKBOSE as and when required.
- e. All the affiliated institutions shall adopt the academic material (i.e. books, etc.) as Published and prescribed by the JKBOSE.
- f. The school management should upgrade the laboratories and library as per the requirements of the syllabi and shall ensure the safety of the chemicals as per the set standards.
- g. It shall be compulsory upon all the academic institutions to adopt the fire safety measures in particular the institution shall ensure the installation of live/functional (ISI brand) fire extinguishers in the schools. This shall be strictly accordance to the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
- h. The school management shall ensure provision of adequate hygienic drinking water. Quality water purifier/s must be installed within the school premises keeping in view the roll of school.

Subject:- Issuance of NOC for affiliation with CBSE in favour of Bhargava Public School, Badheri, Supwal, District Samba.
Reference:- OWP No: 678/12 CMA No. 956/12 Contempt (OWP) No. 39/2013 Order dated 11.12.2013 titled Bhargava Public School, Vs Commissioner/Secretary, School Education Department.

Sir,

I am directed to say that the State Government has "No Objection" for affiliation of Bhargava Public School, Badheri, Supwal, District Samba to run its classes 1st to 10th with Central Board of School Education subject to the fulfillment of following conditions:-

1. 50% or more of its total number of students are children of Central government employees, defence personnel or other people whose services are transferable to places outside the State, people who migrate in connection with business or services in private sector.
2. reserve a minimum of 10% seats in all for children of economically backward persons every year and allow them free-ship. The list of such children shall be provided to the department of Education every year in the beginning of the session;
3. gives due consideration to qualified state subjects while appointing teaching and non-teaching persons;
4. should have at least two members representing the Department of Education, Government of Jammu and Kashmir on its managing committee. The members will be nominated by the education department.
5. undertake to make arrangements for teaching of mother tongue(s) of the children;
6. implement the three language formula.
7. follow a contextualized curriculum which has local culture, traditions and ethos incorporated in it;
8. registration of trust;
9. the list of persons in the Management of the trust;
10. permission, if any, granted by the Director School Education, Jammu for running the school upto 10th class;
11. details of infrastructure, assets etc available with the trust; and
12. undertakes to follow instructions which the State Government may issue from time to time to ensuring quality education in the State.
13. possess infrastructures as prescribed in SRO-123 dated 18th march 2010.
14. possess the drinking water and toilet facility for students & fire extinguisher equipments.

The shall be opened to the inspection by the Director, School Education, Jammu or any other officer authorized by School Education Department.

Further, NOC is granted purely on provisional basis, if the management fail to fulfill the above said conditions within a period of three months NOC granted shall be treated as withdrawn.
